Get Involved in a Committee!!

The Palomar Reserve Board of Directors has 3 active committees that need your support and participation.

Club Houe Committee

This committee is actively working to increase the utilization of the clubhouse and the funds that the CH brings in so that we can pay off the mortgage on the clubhouse.

They have added a CH rental feature to the Palomar Reserve website to promote rentals. The committee is planning a Spring Pot Luck in the CH to allow residents to see how nice it is for renting. This event will also include a sweepstakes

The committee also considered and rejected a couple of ideas for utilization of the CH as being too expensive up front or requiring a zoning variance.

City Grant Committee

This committee searches for city grants that our HOA may be eligible for and prepares applications. We received a grant for 2024 which paid for half of the cost to reseal our asphalt areas (\$6K). We are re-applying for the same grant in 2025 to allow us to replace the sidewalk in front of 4218 and the wall behind 4235. The committee also found a grant to improve the appearance of certain Lexington roadways (including Harrodsburg Road). We have submitted an application for

the city to pay 2/3 of the cost to clear brush from the banks on our property adjacent to this road. The committee is also investigating a grant to improve drainage where the city pays 80% of the cost.

Gardening Committee

This committee works to improve the landscaping and appearance of the property. They are working on a project to replace the 7 flower pots located around the property and to improve our ability to water plants on the property.
